

# Legal terms and conditions of the contest "FESTIVAL AWARDS"

## CLAUSE 1 - ORGANIZING ENTITY.

The European project FESTIVAL (<http://www.festival-project.eu/>), organizes and convenes on the dates hereinafter referred to as the "FESTIVAL Awards" (in "Contest") in accordance with the present Terms.

## CLAUSE 2 - REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS.

To participate in the Contest, participants must register individually in the FESTIVAL EaaS platform before September 29, 2017. The registration process includes filling the application form ([http://www.festival-project.eu/en/?page\\_id=1316](http://www.festival-project.eu/en/?page_id=1316)) and creating an account into the platform afterwards.

Existing experimenter accounts are able to participate in the "FESTIVAL award" without the need of creating a new account.

Participants will have to fill a questionnaire (<http://survey.inno-projects.net/index.php/343776?lang=en>) before September 29, 2017 and provide the details of the experiment being performed.

## CLAUSE 3 – FESTIVAL CONTEST CRITERIA.

This IoT competition aims at rewarding the experimenter who will make use of the FESTIVAL EaaS platform in the most innovative way, by using the tools made available by the project (EaaS API, Experimenter portal, testbeds...) and their resources.

## CLAUSE 4 - AWARD.

There are two (2) awards:

One (1) prize for Japanese experimenters. The prize will consist of ¥10.000 in a book coupon.

One (1) prize for non-japanese experimenters. The prize will consist of ¥10.000 in an Amazon gift card (or the equivalent in €).

The prizes will be granted to the best experiments performed on top of the FESTIVAL EaaS platform.

## CLAUSE 5 - EVALUATION.

The purpose of this Contest is to encourage the use of tools, interfaces and resources provided within the FESTIVAL project, without prejudice to the fact that could be complemented with other software or hardware tools that would facilitate the capture, processing or presentation of the information. For this reason, the main Evaluation criteria of the presented ideas will be:

- 1- Innovation and originality of the experiment.
- 2- Number and heterogeneity of resources used.
- 3- The use of the tools and components provided by FESTIVAL project and the relevance of such use in the experiment presented by the contestant.

It is not an essential requirement, but highly valuable, the presentation of a demonstrator about the experiment.

A jury selected by the organization will evaluate the experiments. Multiple experiments are allowed to the same experimenter, as long as the experiments are different.

The experiments submitted must be original and cannot infringe any intellectual property.

**CLAUSE 6 - RESOLUTION OF THE COMPETITION.**

The resolution of the Competition will be announced on October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017 on the page <http://www.festival-project.eu/>.
